1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11	Amending the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), entitled, as amended, "An act to promote the public health and safety by providing for examination, licensing and granting of permits for those who desire to engage in the profession of cosmetology; defining cosmetology, and regulating cosmetology salons, schools, students, apprentices, teachers, managers, manicurists and cosmetologists; conferring powers and duties upon the Commissioner of Professional and Occupational Affairs in the Department of State; providing for appeals to certain courts by applicants and licensees; and providing penalties," further providing for limited licenses.

14	Section 1. Section 5 of the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242,
15	No.86), referred to as the Cosmetology Law, is amended by adding

18	(b.1) The board shall authorize an owner of a licensed
19	cosmetology salon who converts its cosmetology salon to a
20	limited practice to operate under the owner's current license
21	until its expiration, at which time the owner must secure a
22	limited license.
