AN ACT

- Amending the act of November 24, 2004 (P.L.1270, No.153), 1
- entitled "An act providing for the Pennsylvania Amber Alert
- System; authorizing and directing the Pennsylvania State
- Police to establish and maintain the Pennsylvania Amber Alert
- System; assessing costs; and providing for immunity and penalties," further providing for prohibited use of Amber 5
- 6
- Alerts, for use of missing endangered person advisory system, 7
- for coordination with other jurisdictions and for assessment
- of cost. 9
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10
- 11 hereby enacts as follows:
- 12 Section 1. Sections 2, 2.1 and 3 of the act of November 24,
- 13 2004 (P.L.1270, No.153), referred to as the Pennsylvania Amber
- Alert System Law, amended or added November 23, 2010 (P.L.1363, 14
- No.126), are amended to read: 15
- 16 Section 2. Prohibited use of Amber Alerts.
- 17 The transmission, broadcast or other communication of a
- 18 public alert, other than through the Pennsylvania Amber Alert
- System or the Missing Endangered Person Advisory System, 19
- intentionally, knowingly, recklessly or negligently purporting 20

- 1 to be made by, with or through the authority of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Amber Alert System or the Missing Endangered Person Advisory
- 3 System is prohibited and shall be subject to a civil penalty of
- 4 not more than \$5,000.
- 5 Section 2.1. Use of Missing Endangered Person Advisory System.
- 6 (a) Activation. -- The Pennsylvania Missing Endangered Person
- 7 Advisory System shall be operated by the Pennsylvania State
- 8 Police. Activation may be requested by law enforcement agencies
- 9 when public assistance is considered expedient to the recovery
- 10 of a missing individual believed to be at special risk of harm
- 11 or injury. The ability of law enforcement agencies to
- 12 independently notify or request assistance from the public shall
- 13 not be impaired or restricted in any way.
- 14 (b) Impairments. -- An individual with a physical and mental
- 15 <u>impairment shall qualify as an individual at special risk of</u>
- 16 harm or injury. This qualification shall include, but not be
- 17 <u>limited to, anyone diagnosed with a mental illness or cognitive</u>
- 18 <u>impairment as defined under 55 Pa. Code Pt. VII Ch. 5100</u>
- 19 (relating to mental health procedures) and any disorder in
- 20 <u>accordance with the American Psychiatric Association's</u>
- 21 Diagnostic and Statistical Manual as follows:
- § 299.00 Relating to Autistic Disorder;
- § 299.80 Relating to Rett's Disorder;
- 24 § 290.xx Relating to Dementia of the Alzheimer's Type
- 25 (multiple forms); and
- 26 § 295.xx Relating to Schizophrenia (multiple forms).
- 27 Section 3. Coordination with other jurisdictions.
- The Pennsylvania State Police shall coordinate with the
- 29 authorities of the various states and the Federal Government
- 30 that are responsible within their respective jurisdictions for

- 1 the recovery of abducted children to establish and execute the
- 2 procedures appropriate to the effective fulfillment of its
- 3 responsibilities relating to the Pennsylvania Amber Alert System
- 4 or the Missing Endangered Person Advisory System.
- 5 Section 2. Section 4 of the act is amended to read:
- 6 Section 4. Assessment of cost.
- 7 Unless the court finds that undue hardship would result, in
- 8 addition to any other cost imposed by law, a cost of \$25 shall
- 9 automatically be assessed on each person convicted, adjudicated
- 10 delinguent or granted accelerated rehabilitative disposition
- 11 (ARD) of the offenses named in this section. The cost shall be
- 12 forwarded to the Commonwealth and used by the Pennsylvania State
- 13 Police to establish and maintain the Pennsylvania Amber Alert
- 14 System or the Missing Endangered Person Advisory System and
- 15 apply to the following offenses:
- 16 18 Pa.C.S. § 2901 (relating to kidnapping).
- 17 18 Pa.C.S. § 2902 (relating to unlawful restraint).
- 18 Pa.C.S. § 2903 (relating to false imprisonment).
- 19 18 Pa.C.S. § 2904 (relating to interference with custody
- of children).
- 21 18 Pa.C.S. § 2905 (relating to interference with custody
- of committed persons).
- 23 18 Pa.C.S. § 2906 (relating to criminal coercion).
- 24 18 Pa.C.S. § 2907 (relating to disposition of ransom).
- 25 18 Pa.C.S. § 2908 (relating to missing children).
- 26 18 Pa.C.S. § 2909 (relating to concealment of whereabouts
- of a child).
- 28 18 Pa.C.S. § 2910 (relating to luring a child into a
- 29 motor vehicle).
- 30 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
