## A RESOLUTION

1 2	Directing the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to study intermodal transit in southeastern Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, The regions of this Commonwealth consisting of
4	Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Northampton, Lehigh, Berks,
5	Philadelphia and Montgomery counties are presently served by the
6	following transportation systems:
7	(1) Southeastern Pennsylvania Transportation Authority.
8	(2) Philadelphia Parking Authority.
9	(3) Delaware River Port Authority.
10	(4) Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission;
11	therefore be it
12	RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee
13	make a study of replacing the current transit entities in
14	southeastern Pennsylvania with a regional system to make
15	recommendations for dedicated funds from locally derived sources
16	and meet with the affected transportation systems; and be it
17	further
18	RESOLVED, That among the sources the committee may consider

1 are a levy to be imposed on parking facilities, including 2 airport parking facilities, naming rights, advertising, bridge 3 tolling, privatization of road systems, direct revenue sources 4 derived from tolling of specific lanes or structures or 5 surcharges for use of certain lanes by motorists at specified 6 times during the day; and be it further

7 RESOLVED, That the committee be precluded from identifying 8 any other local revenue derived from the imposition of a realty 9 transfer tax, earned income tax or regional sales tax upon the 10 residents or businesses located within the geographical 11 boundaries of the district without public recommendation from a majority of the members of the committee for any other locally 12 13 derived revenue which would require legislative enactment by the 14 General Assembly; and be it further

15 RESOLVED, That the committee also hold public hearings on the 16 matters to be considered by it at locations throughout 17 southeastern Pennsylvania, including specifically those areas 18 most likely to be served by any system that may replace the 19 existing transit entities in southeastern Pennsylvania. All 20 meetings and public hearings of the committee shall be deemed 21 meetings for the purposes of and subject to 65 Pa.C.S. Ch. 7 22 (relating to open meetings); and be it further 23 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee 24 report its findings and recommendations to the House of 25 Representatives on August 31, 2014; and be it further 26 RESOLVED, That upon receipt of the final report of the 27 committee, the House of Representatives promptly review and 28 consider the recommendations of the committee and develop

29 legislation based on those recommendations for consideration as 30 it deems appropriate.

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
