- 1 Honoring the life and career of Joseph "Butter" Tamburro, WDAS
- radio personality, civil rights leader and Philadelphia icon,
- and extending condolences to his family.
- 4 WHEREAS, Joseph "Butter" Tamburro, a husband, father,
- 5 grandfather, friend and icon passed away on July 27, 2012, at 70
- 6 years of age; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Mr. Tamburro, an Italian American from South
- 8 Philadelphia, was born in 1942; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Tamburro began his career as an advertising
- 10 salesman with WDAS radio in 1964 after a brief stint as an auto
- 11 mechanic; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Mr. Tamburro was given the nickname "Butterball" by
- 13 WDAS Program Director Jimmy Bishop, but became more commonly
- 14 known as "Butter"; and
- 15 WHEREAS, An avid radio listener and admirer of rhythm and
- 16 blues, "Butter" quickly realized his dream and became a part-

- 1 time disc jockey at WDAS, where he hosted the first oldies show
- 2 on African-American radio; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Mr. Tamburro served as the Program Director at WDAS
- 4 for more than 30 years; and
- 5 WHEREAS, "Butter" was well-known for the dance parties he
- 6 hosted at various venues in Philadelphia; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Throughout Mr. Tamburro's career, he received
- 8 several awards and honors from entities like the March of Dimes,
- 9 the Philadelphia Music Alliance, the National Association for
- 10 the Advancement of Colored People, the Black Music Association
- 11 and trade publications such as R&R, Billboard Monitor, Black
- 12 Radio Exclusive and Gavin Magazine; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Mr. Tamburro was also renowned for his involvement
- 14 in the Civil Rights Movement; and
- WHEREAS, He helped spread the message of equality by offering
- 16 the airwaves to civil rights leaders such as the Reverend Martin
- 17 Luther King, Jr., and Attorney Cecil B. Moore; therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives express its
- 19 sadness upon the passing of Joseph "Butter" Tamburro and offer
- 20 its most sincere condolences to his family and friends; and be
- 21 it further
