11	WHEREAS, The celebration is coordinated by the Law-Related
12	Education Committee of the Pennsylvania Bar Association and
13	funded by the Pennsylvania Bar Foundation; and
14	WHEREAS, Schools, attorneys and judges will be encouraged to
15	work together to arrange for classroom visits as part of the
