## A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating the week of October 20 through 26, 2013, as "Pro Bono Week" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Pennsylvania attorneys provide legal assistance at
4	low or no cost, commonly referred to as "pro bono" work, to more
5	than 100,000 low-income clients each year, including 10,000
6	mortgage foreclosure cases and 12,000 domestic violence cases;

8	WHEREAS, The fifth annual National Pro Bono Week will be
9	celebrated at the end of October 2013; and
10	WHEREAS, National Pro Bono Week is an opportunity to
11	highlight the differences attorneys make in their communities,
12	to recruit and train additional pro bono volunteers and to
13	acknowledge the partnerships that form the basis for many of the
14	private bar's most successful pro bono efforts; and
15	WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Bar Association is once again

joining with the American Bar Association to sponsor this
October's annual National Pro Bono Week celebrations; and
WHEREAS, National Pro Bono Week provides numerous
opportunities to highlight the good work Pennsylvania attorneys
do for the most needy among us; and
