A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commemorating the 110th anniversary of Orville and Wilbur
 - Wright's first controlled, powered and sustained heavier-
- 3 than-air human flight.

- 4 WHEREAS, Orville and Wilbur Wright, also known as the Wright
- 5 Brothers, flew the first controlled, powered and sustained
- 6 heavier-than-air human flight on December 17, 1903, on the beach
- 7 at Kill Devil Hills, North Carolina; and
- 8 WHEREAS, They designed and built the Wright Flyer I flying
- 9 machine over a period of years in their bicycle shop; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Their invention of three-axis control was the
- 11 breakthrough essential to controlled flight and is still used on
- 12 fixed-wing aircraft to this day; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The flight marked a historic turning point in the
- 14 pursuit of powered human flight, launching a chain of events
- 15 leading to the landing of a man on the moon, the United States

- 1 Space Shuttle program and the International Space Station; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Their invention significantly advanced the field of
- 3 aviation that unites mankind by reducing travel time and
- 4 effective distance around the globe; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The development of practical airplanes has
- 6 revolutionized transportation, communications, travel,
- 7 agriculture, emergency medical services, law enforcement,
- 8 warfare, search and rescue, disaster relief and environmental
- 9 protection, the benefits of which are enjoyed virtually
- 10 universally; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The aerospace industry is responsible for tens of
- 12 billions of dollars of economic activity and hundreds of
- 13 thousands of jobs in the United States, and Pennsylvania is in
- 14 the top ten states by employment in the aerospace and defense
- 15 industry; and
- 16 WHEREAS, In recent years, The Pennsylvania State University
- 17 has been ranked as the top engineering school for aerospace
- 18 companies; and
- 19 WHEREAS, The Wright Brothers faced skepticism and derision
- 20 when they first publicized their success and converted their
- 21 critics by demonstrating their inventions; and
- 22 WHEREAS, They have served as an inspiration to future
- 23 generations of scientists, engineers and innovators; therefore
- 24 be it
- 25 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commemorate the
- 26 110th anniversary of Orville and Wilbur Wright's first
- 27 controlled, powered and sustained heavier-than-air human flight;
- 28 and be it further
- 29 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor the memory
- 30 of Orville and Wilbur Wright and express its appreciation for

- 1 their heroic contributions to the field of aviation and to all
- 2 of mankind.
