A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of November 2014 as "Childhood Brain Stem Glioma Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania to inform the public 2
- about childhood brain stem glioma; and designating November
- 11, 2014, as "Jax Stone Day" in Pennsylvania to honor one
- individual who passed away from the disease at a young age,
- but was courageous and resilient in his fight. 6
- 7 WHEREAS, Brain stem glioma is a tumor that occurs on the
- brain stem, which is the area of the brain that controls the
- body's breathing, heart rate and muscles used in seeing,
- hearing, walking, talking and eating; and 10
- 11 WHEREAS, Brain stem glioma accounts for approximately 15% of
- 12 all childhood brain tumors and occurs mostly in children between
- 13 five and ten years of age; and
- 14 WHEREAS, There is no known cause of most childhood brain
- tumors, which may be benign or malignant; and 15
- 16 WHEREAS, Symptoms associated with brain stem glioma include

- 1 loss of balance, difficulty walking, headaches, weakness and
- 2 fatigue, vision problems, nausea, vomiting and unusual
- 3 sleepiness or changes in energy level; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The rarity of brain stem glioma and the difficulty
- 5 of surgery and treatment may lead to a rapid course of
- 6 progression; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The prognosis for children suffering from brain stem
- 8 glioma is very poor due to recurring problems even after
- 9 treatment, with most not surviving more than a year following
- 10 diagnosis; and
- 11 WHEREAS, More research is needed to discover the cause of
- 12 brain stem glioma and develop more effective treatments for
- 13 children diagnosed with the disease, like Jax Stone; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Born in Erie on November 11, 2004, Jax was the son
- 15 of Sean Stone and Tara Braendel Durian; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Jax was recently awarded the local "Good Kid of the
- 17 Year" award for his courage throughout his challenging diagnosis
- 18 and the compassion he showed toward others in his community; and
- 19 WHEREAS, The business community in Erie rallied around Jax
- 20 and his family during his fight with brain stem glioma and
- 21 dedicated July 26, 2014, through August 3, 2014, as Jax Stone
- 22 Week for a fundraising campaign for medical and travel expenses;
- 23 and
- 24 WHEREAS, Jax Stone passed away on July 27, 2014, at his
- 25 residence in Erie following a difficult battle with malignant
- 26 brain stem glioma; and
- 27 WHEREAS, Following his tragic passing, the business community
- 28 continued to hold Jax Stone Week to help the family with funeral
- 29 costs; and
- 30 WHEREAS, Jax will be remembered for his kindness, bravery and

- 1 selflessness during his fight with brain stem glioma; therefore

- 3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 4 month of November 2014 as "Childhood Brain Stem Glioma Awareness
- 5 Month" in Pennsylvania to inform the public about childhood
- 6 brain stem glioma; and be it further
- 7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate
- 8 November 11, 2014, as "Jax Stone Day" in Pennsylvania to honor
- 9 one individual who passed away from the disease at a young age,
- 10 but was courageous and resilient in his fight.
