4	WHEREAS, The health of our community's people is the
5	foundation for a caring and productive society, and our future
6	rests with our ability to find cures for, and adequately treat
7	individuals who are afflicted with, a variety of illnesses,
8	including pulmonary hypertension; and
9	WHEREAS, Pulmonary hypertension is a rare disorder causing
10	intolerable blood pressure levels in the arteries between the
11	lungs and heart, and it has been chronic and incurable with a
12	poor survival rate; and
13	WHEREAS, Symptoms of pulmonary hypertension may include chest
14	pain, dizziness, fainting, fatigue, swollen legs and ankles and

1 irregular heartbeat; and

2 WHEREAS, Early diagnosis can lead to early treatment and the 3 possibility of an improved quality of life; and

4 WHEREAS, Education can help with early diagnosis, and funding 5 for research can help find a cure; and

6 WHEREAS, The Pulmonary Hypertension Association is a 7 nonprofit organization dedicated to improving the quality of 8 life for those with pulmonary hypertension through education, 9 awareness, research, member services and patient and family 10 support; therefore be it
