AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for use of farm vehicle plates.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1344(a) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1344. Use of farm vehicle plates.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- A truck or truck tractor bearing farm
- 10 vehicle registration plates shall be used exclusively upon a
- 11 farm or farms owned or operated by the registrant of the vehicle
- 12 or upon highways between:
- 13 (1) Parts of one such farm.
- 14 (2) Such farms.
- 15 (3) Such a farm or farms and a place of business for the
- 16 purpose of buying or selling agricultural commodities or
- 17 supplies.
- 18 (3.1) Such a farm or farms and a secondary school which

the operator of the truck of truck tractor attends for the
purpose of participating in an annual event observed by a
Statewide organization that is dedicated to making a positive
difference in the lives of students by developing their
potential for premier leadership, personal growth and career
success through agricultural education, if all of the
following provisions are satisfied:
(i) the operator is a member of the organization;
(ii) the operator has written permission from the
school to park the truck or truck tractor on the grounds
of the school on the date of the annual event, which
written permission includes the name of the operator, the
address of the farm or farms, the name and address of the
school, the date for which the permission is granted and
the signature of the school official who issued the
permission; and
(iii) the operator carries the written permission
from the school while operating the vehicle between the
farm or farms and the school on that date.
(4) Such place of business, if transported to the place
of business pursuant to paragraph (3) and the place of
delivery of the agricultural commodities, provided that:
(i) delivery is made pursuant to the sale of the
commodities by the registrant of the vehicle, by an
employee of the vehicle registrant or by an auctioneer;
and
(ii) if transported to the place of business
pursuant to paragraph (3), delivery is made by the same
vehicle of the registrant which transported the
commodities to the place of business.

- 2 examination of an applicant for a driver's license.

(6) Such farm or farms and a place of business for the

- 4 inspection, repair or servicing of the vehicle.

6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
