13	It shall not be unlawful and no prior court approval shall be
14	required under this chapter for:

16	(16) A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, WHETHER OR NOT CERTIFIED <
17	UNDER SECTION 5724 (RELATING TO TRAINING), ACTING IN THE

PERFORMANCE OF HIS OFFICIAL DUTIES TO INTERCEPT AND RECORD AN
 ORAL COMMUNICATION BETWEEN INDIVIDUALS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
 FOLLOWING:

4 (I) AT THE TIME OF THE INTERCEPTION, THE ORAL
5 COMMUNICATION DOES NOT OCCUR INSIDE THE RESIDENCE OF ANY
6 OF THE INDIVIDUALS.

7 (II) AT THE TIME OF THE INTERCEPTION, THE LAW
8 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER:

9 (A) IS OPERATING THE VISUAL OR AUDIBLE WARNING 10 SYSTEM OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER'S VEHICLE 11 AUTHORIZED BY 75 PA.C.S. § 4571 (RELATING TO VISUAL 12 AND AUDIBLE SIGNALS ON EMERGENCY VEHICLES) OR IS 13 CLEARLY IDENTIFIABLE AS A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER;

14 (B) IS IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO THE INDIVIDUALS'15 ORAL COMMUNICATION;

(C) IS USING AN ELECTRONIC, MECHANICAL OR OTHER 16 DEVICE WHICH HAS BEEN APPROVED UNDER SECTION 5706(B) 17 18 (4) (RELATING TO EXCEPTIONS TO PROHIBITIONS IN POSSESSION, SALE, DISTRIBUTION, MANUFACTURE OR 19 20 ADVERTISEMENT OF ELECTRONIC, MECHANICAL OR OTHER DEVICES) TO INTERCEPT THE ORAL COMMUNICATION[, THE 21 RECORDER OF WHICH IS MOUNTED IN THE LAW ENFORCEMENT 22 23 OFFICER'S VEHICLE]; AND

(D) INFORMS, AS SOON AS REASONABLY PRACTICABLE,
THE INDIVIDUALS IDENTIFIABLY PRESENT THAT HE HAS
INTERCEPTED AND RECORDED THE ORAL COMMUNICATION.

1 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER" MEANS A MEMBER OF THE PENNSYLVANIA 2 STATE POLICE OR AN INDIVIDUAL EMPLOYED AS A POLICE OFFICER WHO HOLDS A CURRENT CERTIFICATE UNDER 53 PA.C.S. 3 CH. 21 SUBCH. D (RELATING TO MUNICIPAL POLICE EDUCATION 4 AND TRAINING). 5 ["RECORDER." AN ELECTRONIC, MECHANICAL OR OTHER 6 7 DEVICE USED TO STORE AN ORAL COMMUNICATION ON TAPE OR ON 8 SOME OTHER COMPARABLE MEDIUM.] 9 * * * 10 (18) A person to intercept oral communications for disciplinary or security purposes on a school bus or school 11 12 vehicle, as those terms are defined in 75 Pa.C.S. § 102 (relating to definitions), if all of the following conditions 13 14 are met: 15 (i) The school board has adopted a policy that 16 authorizes audio interception on school buses or school vehicles for disciplinary or security purposes. 17 (ii) Each school year, the school board notifies 18 19 students and their parents or guardians of the policy, by letter mailed to the students' home addresses. 20 (iii) The school board posts a notice that students 21 22 may be audiotaped, which notice is clearly visible on 23 each school bus or school vehicle that is furnished with 24 audio-recording equipment.
