AN ACT

Amending the act of January 25, 1966 (1965 P.L.1546, No.541), 1 entitled "An act providing scholarships and providing funds 2 to secure Federal funds for qualified students of the 3 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania who need financial assistance to attend postsecondary institutions of higher learning, making an appropriation, and providing for the administration of this act," further providing for eligibility of scholarships <--ESTABLISHING THE DISTANCE EDUCATION PROGRAM. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 11 Section 1. Section 4(a)(6) of the act of January 25, 1966 12 (1965 P.L.1546, No.541), referred to as the Higher Education 13 Scholarship Law, is amended to read: 14 Section 4. (a) Any student is eligible for consideration 15 for a State scholarship providing: * * * 16 17 (6) The State scholarship recipient shall be free to 18 [attend] enroll_at any approved institution of his choice and 19 apply the scholarship toward the tuition, room, board, books and 20 fees of that institution, regardless of the percentage of credit

- 1 or clock hours required for completing a program of study
- 2 through online courses. The institution is not required to
- 3 accept the scholarship recipient for enrollment, but is free to-
- 4 exact compliance with its own admission requirements, standards
- 5 and policies.

- 7 SECTION 1. THE ACT OF JANUARY 25, 1966 (1965 P.L.1546, <--
- 8 NO.541), REFERRED TO AS THE HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP LAW, IS
- 9 AMENDED BY ADDING A SECTION TO READ:
- 10 <u>SECTION 8.5. (A) THE DISTANCE EDUCATION PROGRAM IS</u>
- 11 ESTABLISHED IN THE AGENCY TO APPROVE DISTANCE EDUCATION PROGRAMS
- 12 AND TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO STUDENTS WHO ENROLL IN APPROVED
- 13 <u>DISTANCE EDUCATION PROGRAMS.</u>
- 14 (B) THE AGENCY SHALL ADMINISTER AND ESTABLISH GUIDELINES FOR
- 15 THE DISTANCE EDUCATION PROGRAM. THE AGENCY MAY COLLECT STUDENT
- 16 AND SCHOOL DATA TO ASSESS THE PERFORMANCE OF THE DISTANCE
- 17 EDUCATION PROGRAM, PROVIDED THAT SUCH COLLECTION COMPLIES WITH
- 18 THE RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES CERTIFICATION DOCUMENT OF THE
- 19 PENNSYLVANIA STATE GRANT PROGRAM AS ADMINISTERED BY THE AGENCY.
- 20 (C) AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION MAY SUBMIT AN
- 21 APPLICATION TO THE AGENCY FOR APPROVAL TO PARTICIPATE IN THE
- 22 DISTANCE EDUCATION PROGRAM. THE APPLICATION MUST BE SUBMITTED IN
- 23 SUCH FORM AND MANNER AS PRESCRIBED BY THE AGENCY.
- 24 (D) THE AGENCY SHALL REVIEW REQUESTS SUBMITTED UNDER
- 25 SUBSECTION (C) AND, IF THE INSTITUTION MEETS THE CRITERIA
- 26 SPECIFIED IN THE DEFINITION OF "INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION"
- 27 AND "APPROVED DISTANCE EDUCATION PROGRAM," SHALL APPROVE THE
- 28 REQUEST. THE AGENCY SHALL APPROVE REQUESTS RELATED TO ALL
- 29 ACADEMIC MAJORS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE UNDER THE STATE GRANT PROGRAM.
- 30 (E) THE AGENCY MAY AWARD, FROM FUNDS APPROPRIATED, ALLOCATED

- 1 OR OTHERWISE MADE AVAILABLE TO IT, GRANTS TO STUDENTS WHO ARE
- 2 ENROLLED IN APPROVED DISTANCE EDUCATION PROGRAMS AT
- 3 PARTICIPATING INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION. THE AGENCY SHALL
- 4 ESTABLISH A POLICY TO ENSURE THAT AWARDS ARE MADE IN A
- 5 CONSISTENT MANNER THROUGHOUT THE AWARD YEAR.
- 6 (F) A STUDENT ENROLLED IN AN APPROVED DISTANCE EDUCATION
- 7 PROGRAM SHALL SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A STATE GRANT FROM THE
- 8 AGENCY. THE APPLICATION MUST BE SUBMITTED IN SUCH FORM AND IN A
- 9 MANNER AS PRESCRIBED BY THE AGENCY.
- 10 (G) THE AGENCY SHALL REVIEW AN APPLICATION SUBMITTED UNDER
- 11 SUBSECTION (F) AND, BASED ON AVAILABLE RESOURCES, IF THE AGENCY
- 12 CONCLUDES THAT THE APPLICANT HAS FINANCIAL NEED, MAY AWARD A
- 13 STATE GRANT TO THE APPLICANT TO COVER THE COST OF FULL-TIME OR
- 14 AT LEAST HALF-TIME STUDY IN THE APPROVED DISTANCE EDUCATION
- 15 PROGRAM AT AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION APPROVED FOR
- 16 PARTICIPATION IN THE DISTANCE EDUCATION PROGRAM.
- 17 (H) A GRANT AWARDED TO A STUDENT UNDER SUBSECTION (G) MAY
- 18 NOT EXCEED PER AWARD YEAR THE AMOUNT THE STUDENT WOULD RECEIVE
- 19 UNDER THE STATE GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE SAME AWARD YEAR.
- 20 (I) THIS SECTION SHALL APPLY TO ACADEMIC YEARS 2013-2014
- 21 THROUGH 2017-2018.
- 22 (J) THIS SECTION SHALL EXPIRE JUNE 30, 2018.
- 23 (K) THE FOLLOWING WORDS AND PHRASES SHALL HAVE THE MEANING
- 24 GIVEN TO THEM IN THIS SECTION UNLESS THE CONTEXT CLEARLY
- 25 <u>INDICATES OTHERWISE:</u>
- 26 "APPROVED DISTANCE EDUCATION PROGRAM." A PROGRAM OF STUDY
- 27 OFFERED BY AN INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION THAT IS APPROVED
- 28 BY THE AGENCY AND MEETS THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:
- 29 (I) THE PROGRAM IS AT LEAST TWO ACADEMIC YEARS IN LENGTH.
- 30 (II) COMPLETION OF THE PROGRAM LEADS TO THE ATTAINMENT OF A

- 1 RECOGNIZED ACADEMIC CREDENTIAL.
- 2 (III) THE PROGRAM OF STUDY SHALL ALLOW AN ELIGIBLE STUDENT
- 3 TO TAKE MORE THAN FIFTY PERCENT OF CREDITS OR CLOCK HOURS
- 4 THROUGH DISTANCE EDUCATION FOR EACH PAYMENT PERIOD IN WHICH THE
- 5 <u>ELIGIBLE STUDENT IS ENROLLED.</u>
- 6 (IV) THE PROGRAM MUST BE PURSUED BY STUDENTS ON A FULL-TIME
- 7 BASIS OR AT LEAST A HALF-TIME BASIS.
- 8 "DISTANCE EDUCATION PROGRAM." THE DISTANCE EDUCATION PROGRAM
- 9 ESTABLISHED BY THIS SECTION.
- 10 "ELIGIBLE STUDENT." A STUDENT WHO IS OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE FOR
- 11 THE STATE GRANT PROGRAM, NOTWITHSTANDING THE DISTANCE EDUCATION
- 12 REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE GRANT PROGRAM.
- "INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION." A POSTSECONDARY
- 14 <u>INSTITUTION THAT PARTICIPATED IN THE STATE GRANT PROGRAM AS OF</u>
- 15 JUNE 30, 2012, AND IS DOMICILED AND HEADQUARTERED WITH ITS
- 16 PRINCIPAL PHYSICAL LOCATION IN THIS COMMONWEALTH.
- 17 "PHYSICAL LOCATION." A LOCATION WITH QUALIFIED ON-SITE
- 18 <u>ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF RESPONSIBLE FOR THE OVERALL ADMINISTRATIVE</u>
- 19 OPERATION OF ALL EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING, BUT NOT
- 20 LIMITED TO, INSTRUCTIONAL OVERSIGHT, COUNSELING, ADVISING,
- 21 LIBRARY SERVICES AND MAINTENANCE OF ACADEMIC RECORDS.
- 22 "STATE GRANT." A GRANT OR SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED UNDER THIS
- 23 ACT.
- 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. JULY 1, <--
- 25 2013, OR IMMEDIATELY, WHICHEVER IS LATER.
