AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An-<-act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in teacher certification, furtherproviding for qualifying certificates and kinds of certificates. AMENDING THE ACT OF MARCH 10, 1949 (P.L.30, NO.14), ENTITLED "AN <--8 ACT RELATING TO THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM, INCLUDING CERTAIN 9 PROVISIONS APPLICABLE AS WELL TO PRIVATE AND PAROCHIAL 10 SCHOOLS; AMENDING, REVISING, CONSOLIDATING AND CHANGING THE 11 LAWS RELATING THERETO," IN TEACHER CERTIFICATION, PROVIDING 12 FOR MILITARY SCIENCE CERTIFICATES. 13 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Sections 1201 and 1203 of the act of March 10, <--16 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, 17 amended June 30, 2011 (P.L.112, No.24), are amended to read: 18 Section 1201. Certificates Qualifying Persons to Teach. 19 20 Only those persons holding one of the following certificates 21 shall be qualified to teach in the public schools of this Commonwealth (1) Permanent college certificate, (2) provisional college certificate, (3) normal school diploma, (4) normal

- 1 school certificate, (5) special permanent certificate, (6)
- 2 special temporary certificate, (7) permanent State certificate,
- 3 (8) residency certificate, (8.1) military science certificate,
- 4 (9) intern certificate, (10) certificates which are permanent
- 5 licenses to teach by virtue of the provisions of section one-
- 6 thousand three hundred eight of the act, approved the eighteenth-
- 7 day of May, one thousand nine hundred eleven (Pamphlet Laws-
- 8 309), as amended, which is repealed hereby, or (11) such other-
- 9 kinds of certificates as are issued under the standards
- 10 prescribed by the State Board of Education. The State Board of
- 11 Education shall also provide for issuance of certificates by
- 12 district superintendents to meet such emergencies or shortage of
- 13 teachers as may occur.
- 14 Section 1203. Kinds of State Certificates. (a) State
- 15 certificates hereafter granted shall include the following:
- 16 Provisional College Certificates,
- 17 Permanent College Certificates,
- 18 Certificates issued by other states and validated by the
- 19 Superintendent of Public Instruction,
- 20 Special Temporary Certificates,
- 21 Special Permanent Certificates,
- 22 Residency Certificates,
- 23 Intern Certificates.
- 24 <u>Military Science Certificates.</u>
- 25 (b) All persons receiving any of such certificates shall-
- 26 have qualifications not less than graduation from a State-
- 27 Teachers' College of this Commonwealth, or equivalent training.
- 28 Postbaccalaureate certification programs, including residency,
- 29 intern and administrative certification programs completed under-
- 30 section 1207.1 are equivalent training for purposes of this act.

- 1 (b.1) All persons receiving military science certificates
- 2 shall have documentation of at least twenty years' military
- 3 <u>service and certification by the appropriate branch of the armed</u>
- 4 <u>forces of the United States authorizing employment as a military</u>
- 5 science instructor.
- 6 (c) Every college certificate shall set forth the names of
- 7 the college or university from which its holder was graduated.
- 8 State certificates shall entitle their holders to teach in every-
- 9 part of this Commonwealth for the terms herein specified.
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
- 11 SECTION 1. THE ACT OF MARCH 10, 1949 (P.L.30, NO.14), KNOWN <--
- 12 AS THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CODE OF 1949, IS AMENDED BY ADDING A
- 13 SECTION TO READ:
- 14 <u>SECTION 1207.2. MILITARY SCIENCE CERTIFICATES.--(A)</u>
- 15 NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW TO THE CONTRARY, THE
- 16 <u>SECRETARY OF EDUCATION MAY ISSUE A PENNSYLVANIA MILITARY SCIENCE</u>
- 17 TEACHING CERTIFICATE TO A PERSON WHO MEETS THE FOLLOWING:
- 18 (1) POSSESSES A VALID MILITARY SCIENCE CERTIFICATE OR
- 19 ENDORSEMENT ISSUED BY A BRANCH OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES
- 20 AUTHORIZING THE PERSON TO TEACH MILITARY SCIENCE AND THE JUNIOR
- 21 RESERVE OFFICER TRAINING CORPS; AND
- 22 (2) SATISFIES THE REOUIREMENTS UNDER SECTION 1209.
- 23 (B) A PENNSYLVANIA MILITARY SCIENCE CERTIFICATE MAY BE
- 24 ISSUED TO A PERSON POSSESSING THE QUALIFICATIONS LISTED UNDER
- 25 SUBSECTION (A) (1) AND (2) WITHOUT MEETING ADDITIONAL EDUCATION
- 26 AND ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENTS FOR ISSUANCE.
- 27 (C) A PENNSYLVANIA MILITARY SCIENCE CERTIFICATE ISSUED UNDER
- 28 THIS SECTION SHALL QUALIFY A PERSON TO TEACH MILITARY SCIENCE OR
- 29 JUNIOR RESERVE OFFICER TRAINING CORPS IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF
- 30 THIS COMMONWEALTH.

- 1 (D) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER THIS SECTION, NO AREA OF
- 2 <u>CERTIFICATION MAY BE ADDED TO A PENNSYLVANIA MILITARY SCIENCE</u>
- 3 CERTIFICATE THROUGH ONLY TESTING UNLESS THE PERSON HOLDS A VALID
- 4 PENNSYLVANIA INSTRUCTIONAL CERTIFICATE ENDORSED IN ANOTHER
- 5 <u>SUBJECT AREA.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 60 DAYS.
