- 1 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in hunting and furtaking licenses, further
- providing for license requirements and for unlawful acts
- 4 concerning licenses.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Sections 2701(a) and 2711(a.1) of Title 34 of the
- 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 9 § 2701. License requirements.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- Except in defense of person or property
- 11 or pursuant to exemptions authorized in this title or by
- 12 regulation of the commission for implementing a mentored [youth]
- 13 hunting program, every person, prior to engaging in any of the
- 14 privileges granted by this title, shall first obtain the
- 15 applicable license subject to any conditions or other
- 16 requirements imposed by this title.

- 1 § 2711. Unlawful acts concerning licenses.
- 2 * * *
- 3 (a.1) Exemption. -- For the sole purpose of implementing and
- 4 enhancing a mentored [youth] hunting program within this
- 5 Commonwealth, the commission may establish regulations exempting
- 6 certain limited [youth] hunting activities from the prohibitions
- 7 specified in subsection (a)(1), (3), (5) and (8). Such exemption
- 8 shall include a provision limiting a mentored [youth] person
- 9 participating in a mentored [youth] hunting program to the
- 10 receipt of no more than one antlerless deer license in each
- 11 license year.
