6	Section 1. Section 8802 of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
8	§ 8802. Definitions.
9	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
10	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
11	context clearly indicates otherwise:

13	"High tunnel." A temporary covered agricultural structure
14	which meets the following:
15	(1) Is used for agricultural purposes, including any of
16	the following:
17	(i) Growing, processing or storing agricultural

1	products.
2	(ii) Shelter for the sale of agricultural products.
3	(iii) Housing livestock.
4	(iv) Storage of agricultural waste, equipment and
5	other material used in agricultural production.
6	(2) Is constructed consistent with all of the following:
7	(i) Has a metal, wood or plastic frame.
8	(ii) Has a plastic, woven textile or other flexible
9	covering.
10	(iii) Has a floor made of soil, crushed stone,
11	matting, pavers or a floating concrete slab.
12	(iv) Requirements determined by the Department of
13	Revenue in consultation with the Department of
14	<u>Agriculture.</u>

16	Section 2. Section 8812(a) of Title 53 is amended by adding
17	a paragraph to read:
18	§ 8812. Exemptions from taxation.
19	(a) General ruleThe following property shall be exempt
20	from all county, city, borough, town, township, road, poor,
21	county institution district and school real estate taxes:

23	(16) All high tunnels.

25	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
