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AN ACT

Amending the act of May 28, 1923 (P.L.458, No.250), entitled "An act authorizing the Department of Forestry, with the approval of the Governor and Attorney General, to lease for periods of 3 not more than fifty years, on terms, conditions, and 4 stipulations expressed in each lease, any portions of the State forests for dams, reservoirs, canals, pipe lines and other water conduits, power houses and transmission lines, for the development of water power, for steam raising and 7 condensation, and for the generation and transmission of 9 electric energy," providing for wind, solar and other 10 renewable energy projects. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 13 14 Section 1. The title and section 1 of the act of May 28, 15 1923 (P.L.458, No.250), entitled "An act authorizing the Department of Forestry, with the approval of the Governor and 16 17 Attorney General, to lease for periods of not more than fifty 18 years, on terms, conditions, and stipulations expressed in each lease, any portions of the State forests for dams, reservoirs, 19 20 canals, pipe lines and other water conduits, power houses and 21 transmission lines, for the development of water power, for

steam raising and condensation, and for the generation and

- 1 transmission of electric energy," are amended to read:
- 2 AN ACT
- 3 Authorizing the Department of [Forestry] Conservation and
- 4 <u>Natural Resources</u>, with the approval of the Governor [and
- 5 Attorney General], to lease for periods of not more than
- fifty years, on terms, conditions, and stipulations expressed
- 7 in each lease, any portions of the State forests for dams,
- 8 reservoirs, canals, pipe lines and other water conduits,
- 9 power houses and transmission lines, for the development of
- 10 water power, for steam raising and condensation, <u>for wind</u>,
- 11 <u>solar or other renewable energy projects</u>, and for the
- 12 generation and transmission of electric energy.
- 13 Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the [Department of
- 14 Forestry] Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, with
- 15 the approval of the Governor [and Attorney General], is hereby
- 16 authorized, in its discretion, to lease for periods of not more
- 17 than fifty years any portions of the State forests for use as
- 18 sites for dams and other water obstructions, reservoirs, canals,
- 19 pipe lines, and/or other water conduits for the purpose of the
- 20 development of water power and/or for the main purpose of
- 21 storage, conveyance, and/or cooling of water for steam raising
- 22 and/or steam condensation in the generation of electric energy
- 23 for public service, and/or for use as sites for wind turbines
- 24 and other wind energy facilities, and/or solar energy
- 25 <u>facilities</u>, and/or other renewable energy facilities, and/or for
- 26 use as sites for power houses and/or transmission lines for the
- 27 generation and transmission of electric energy. Every such lease
- 28 shall be on such terms, conditions, and stipulations, expressed
- 29 in each lease, as the department, with the approval of the
- 30 Governor [and Attorney General], shall deem necessary for the

- 1 protection of the present and future interests of the
- 2 Commonwealth and its people and suitable for affording a
- 3 reasonable opportunity for a fair return on the actual
- 4 investment prudently made on the faith of such lease, which may
- 5 include provisions not repugnant to the rights of the United
- 6 States, its permittees, licensees, or transferees, existing at
- 7 the time of the making of such lease, reserving an option in the
- 8 Commonwealth to renew or extend for not more than fifty (50)
- 9 years such lease, or to take over the project works, by and for
- 10 itself or by and for another prospective lessee, upon payment by
- 11 the Commonwealth or by such other prospective lessee of the
- 12 actual net investment in the project works, by which is meant a
- 13 complete unit of improvement or development consisting of a
- 14 power house and appurtenant works, all water conduits, all dams
- 15 and works appurtenant thereto which are a part of said unit, and
- 16 all storage, diverting, or forebay reservoirs directly connected
- 17 therewith, all wind, solar or other renewable energy facilities,
- 18 the primary line or lines transmitting power from the power
- 19 house, wind turbine, solar panel or other renewable energy
- 20 <u>facility</u> to the point of junction with the distribution system
- 21 or with an interconnected primary transmission system, all
- 22 miscellaneous structures used and useful in connection with such
- 23 unit or any part thereof, and all water rights, rights of way,
- 24 ditches, dams, reservoirs, wind turbines, solar panels, other
- 25 <u>renewable energy facilities</u>, lands, or interest in lands, the
- 26 use and occupancy of which are necessary or appropriate in the
- 27 maintenance and operation of such unit. A proposed lease shall
- 28 <u>be advertised once a week for three weeks, in at least two</u>
- 29 <u>newspapers of general circulation published nearest the county</u>
- 30 <u>indicated</u>, in advance of awarding the lease. The lease may then_

- 1 be awarded to the highest and best bidder or offer or based on
- 2 <u>criteria established by the Department of Conservation and</u>
- 3 Natural Resources. The lessee shall give bond for the proper
- 4 performance of the lease as the Department of Conservation and
- 5 Natural Resources shall designate. The rents and proceeds from
- 6 the leases shall be placed in the Oil and Gas Lease Fund
- 7 <u>established under the act of December 15, 1955 (P.L.865,</u>
- 8 No.256), entitled "An act requiring rents and royalties from oil
- 9 and gas leases of Commonwealth land to be placed in a special
- 10 <u>fund to be used for conservation, recreation, dams, and flood</u>
- 11 control; authorizing the Secretary of Forests and Waters to
- 12 <u>determine the need for and location of such projects and to</u>
- 13 acquire the necessary land," and expended in accordance with
- 14 that act.
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
