REFERRED TO APPROPRIATIONS, MARCH 20, 2013

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act of July 7, 1972 (P.L.743, No.176), entitled "An act 1 providing for the establishment and operation of Lincoln 2 University as an instrumentality of the Commonwealth to serve 3 as a State-related institution in the higher education system 4 of the Commonwealth; providing for change of name; providing 5 for the composition of the board of trustees; terms of 6 7 trustees, and the power and duties of such trustees; providing for preference to Pennsylvania residents in 8 tuition; authorizing appropriations in amounts to be fixed 9 annually by the General Assembly; providing for the auditing 10 of accounts of expenditures from said appropriations; 11 providing for public support and capital improvements; 12 authorizing the issuance of bonds exempt from taxation within 13 the Commonwealth; requiring the President to make an annual report of the operations of Lincoln University," making an 14 15 appropriation for carrying the same into effect; providing 16 for a basis for payments of the appropriation; and providing 17 18 a method of accounting for the funds appropriated and for certain fiscal information disclosure. 19

20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

21 hereby enacts as follows:

22 Section 1. The sum of \$11,163,000, or as much thereof as may

23 be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Trustees of Lincoln

24 University, Chester County, for the fiscal year July 1, 2013, to

25 June 30, 2014, for general support.

26 Section 2. Payments to Lincoln University on account of the 27 appropriation provided in section 1 shall be made on the basis 1 of costs during the fiscal year.

Section 3. (a) Payments to Lincoln University of the appropriation provided in section 1 shall be made monthly during the fiscal year.

5 (b) Such monthly payments shall be made in accordance with 6 the provisions of section 2 on the basis of estimated costs. The 7 estimate of costs shall be submitted by Lincoln University to 8 the Secretary of Education, the General Assembly and the State 9 Treasurer not later than 30 days prior to the date on which such 10 payment is to be made.

11 Section 4. (a) Lincoln University shall apply the moneys appropriated by this act only for such purposes as are permitted 12 13 in this act and shall at all times maintain proper records 14 showing the application of such moneys. Not later than 120 days 15 after the close of the fiscal year to which this act relates, 16 Lincoln University shall file, with the Secretary of Education, the General Assembly and the Auditor General of the 17 18 Commonwealth, a statement setting forth the amounts and purposes 19 of all expenditures made from moneys appropriated by this act 20 and costs, as provided in section 2, used as a basis for receipt of any appropriation during said fiscal year. 21

22 Such statement of expenditures and costs shall be (b) 23 reviewed by the Auditor General of the Commonwealth, and he 24 shall have the right, in respect to the moneys appropriated by 25 this act, to audit and disallow expenditures made for purposes not permitted by this act and to cause such sums to be recovered 26 and paid by Lincoln University to the State Treasurer. In 27 28 respect to expenditures made by the university from moneys other 29 than those appropriated by this act, the Auditor General shall have the right to review only, and he shall file annually with 30

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the General Assembly such information concerning said
 expenditures as the General Assembly or any of its committees
 may require.

Section 5. The Lincoln University shall provide full,
complete and accurate information as may be required by the
Department of Education or the chairman or the minority chairman
of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate or the chairman or
the minority chairman of the Appropriations Committee of the
House of Representatives.

10 Section 6. Lincoln University shall present and report its financial statements required under the provisions of this act 11 12 in accordance with: the generally accepted accounting principles 13 as prescribed by the National Association of College and 14 University Business Officers, the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants, or their successors, or by any 15 16 other recognized authoritative body; the "Commonwealth of 17 Pennsylvania Budget Instructions for the State System of Higher 18 Education, State-Related Universities and Non-State-Related 19 Colleges and Universities"; and the financial reporting policies 20 and standards promulgated by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 21 and by the Federal Government that apply to Lincoln University. 22 Section 7. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013, or 23 immediately, whichever is later.

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
