## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in railroads, providing for whistle post signage.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	<u>§ 2710. Whistle post signage.</u>
9	(a) DutyA public utility engaged in a railroad business
10	shall place whistle post signs to the right of the main track in
11	the direction of approach exactly one-quarter of a mile from the
12	entrance to crossings to notify engineers or operators of
13	locomotives who blow a whistle and ring a bell as the locomotive
14	approaches the crossing as a warning to the public.
15	(b) SignsThe whistle post signs shall consist of a "W"
16	identifiable on a square plate mounted on a post and shall be:
17	(1) Visible to an engineer or operator of a locomotive
18	within the cabin or caboose car.

- 1 <u>(2) Kept in good repair.</u>
- 2 (3) Replaced promptly when necessary.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
