## AN ACT

- 1 Selecting, designating and adopting the phrase "Ubi libertas vivit, hic patria mihi" as the official Latin motto of the
- 3 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- 4 The General Assembly finds that:
- 5 (1) The phrase "Ubi libertas vivit, hic patria mihi" is
- 6 the Latin translation of a quote attributed to the
- 7 Pennsylvania statesman Benjamin Franklin.
- 8 (2) The English translation of the phrase is "Where
- 9 liberty is, there is my country."
- 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 11 hereby enacts as follows:
- 12 Section 1. Official State Latin motto.
- The quote "Ubi libertas vivit, hic patria mihi" is selected,
- 14 designated and adopted as the official Latin motto of the
- 15 Commonwealth.
- 16 Section 2. Effective date.
- 17 This act shall take effect immediately.
