## AN ACT

1 2 3 4	Amending Title 65 (Public Officers) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for definitions, for statement of financial interests required to be filed and for powers and duties of commission.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 1102 of Title 65 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
9	§ 1102. Definitions.
10	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
11	shall have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the
12	meanings given to them in this section:
13	* * *
14	"Political party officer." An individual holding the office
15	of chairman, vice-chairman, secretary or treasurer for a
16	political party at the State or county level.

18	Section 2. Section 1104(a) and (e) of Title 65 are amended

and the section is amended by adding subsections to read: 1 2 § 1104. Statement of financial interests required to be filed. 3 (a) Public official or public employee.--Each public official of the Commonwealth and political party officer shall 4 file a statement of financial interests for the preceding 5 calendar year with the commission no later than May 1 of each 6 7 year that he holds such a position and of the year after he 8 leaves such a position. Each public employee and public official of the Commonwealth shall file a statement of financial 9 10 interests for the preceding calendar year with the department, agency, body or bureau in which he is employed or to which he is 11 appointed or elected no later than May 1 of each year that he 12 13 holds such a position and of the year after he leaves such a position. Any other public employee or public official shall 14 15 file a statement of financial interests with the governing 16 authority of the political subdivision by which he is employed or within which he is appointed or elected no later than May 1 17 18 of each year that he holds such a position and of the year after he leaves such a position. Persons who are full-time or part-19 20 time solicitors for political subdivisions are required to file 21 under this section.

(a.1) Statewide official and member of the General
Assembly.--Beginning May 1, 2015, and each May 1 thereafter, a
Statewide official and member of the General Assembly shall file
electronically the statement of financial interests required
under subsection (a). The filing must be in a form and manner
prescribed by the commission.
(a.2) Political party officer.--Beginning May 1, 2015, and

29 <u>each May 1 thereafter, a political party officer shall make the</u> 30 <u>required filing under subsection (a).</u>

2 (e) Public inspection and copying.--All statements of
3 financial interests filed pursuant to the provisions of this
4 chapter shall be [made]:

5 <u>(1) made</u> available for public inspection and copying 6 during regular office hours, and copying facilities shall be 7 made available at a charge not to exceed actual cost; and 8 <u>(2) posted on the publicly accessible Internet websites</u> 9 <u>of the commission and other State agencies that receive and</u> 10 <u>file statements of financial interests</u>.

Section 3. Section 1107(6) and (7) of Title 65 are amended and the section is amended by adding paragraphs to read: \$ 1107. Powers and duties of commission.

14 In addition to other powers and duties prescribed by law, the 15 commission shall:

17 (6) (i) Provide that statements and reports filed with 18 the commission be made available for public inspection 19 and copying during regular office hours and provide that 20 copying facilities be made available at a charge not to 21 exceed actual cost [and advise].

22 (ii) Post on its publicly accessible Internet
 23 website the statements of financial interests required to
 24 be filed with it.

25 (iii) Advise other State and local agencies of the
 26 provisions of this paragraph.

(7) Compile and maintain an index, including a database
 on its publicly accessible Internet website, of all reports
 and statements filed with the commission to facilitate public
 access to such reports and statements and instruct other

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1	State and local agencies which receive and file financial
2	interest statements in the maintenance of systems, including
3	publicly accessible Internet websites, which facilitate
4	public access to such statements. The database required under
5	this paragraph shall be searchable and sortable by, at a
6	minimum, the following:
7	(i) The name of the individual filing the report or
8	statement.
9	(ii) The office held by the individual filing the
10	report or statement.
11	(iii) The year the form was filed.
12	(iv) Whether or not the form is an amended filing.
13	The database required under this paragraph shall be
14	<u>operational no later than May 1, 2015.</u>
15	(7.1) Connect an amended filing to the original filing
16	on its publicly accessible Internet website in a way that a
17	person accessing one will be notified of the existence of the
18	<u>other.</u>
19	(7.2) Provide an e-mail notification option for a person
20	who would like to be notified of new filings.

22	Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
