A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for exemptions and special provisions.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
6	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
8	That section 2(c) of Article VIII be amended to read:
9	§ 2. Exemptions and special provisions.

11	(c) Citizens and residents of this Commonwealth, who served
12	in any war or armed conflict in which the United States was
13	engaged and were honorably discharged or released under
14	honorable circumstances from active service, shall be exempt
15	from the payment of all real property taxes upon the residence
16	occupied by the said citizens and residents of this Commonwealth
17	imposed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any of its

political subdivisions if, as a result of military service, they 1 2 are blind, paraplegic or double or quadruple amputees or have a 3 service-connected disability declared by the United States [Veterans Administration] Department of Veterans Affairs or its 4 successor to be a total or 100% service-connected and permanent 5 disability[, and if the State Veterans' Commission determines 6 7 that such persons are in need of the tax exemptions granted 8 herein]. This exemption shall be extended to the unmarried 9 surviving spouse upon the death of an eligible veteran [provided 10 that the State Veterans' Commission determines that such person is in need of the exemption.] and, after the death of an 11 12 eligible veteran resulting from a service-connected injury or disease, as determined by the United States Department of 13 14 Veterans Affairs or its successor, to the unmarried surviving spouse of a person killed in action performing active duty in 15 16 the armed forces of the United States in war or armed conflict or as a result of peacetime terrorist attack or hostile action_ 17 18 as determined by the Adjutant General.

19 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General 20 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to 21 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article 22 23 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the 24 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 25 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of this proposed constitutional amendment. 26

(b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the

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1 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 2 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of 3 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 4 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 5 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 6 primary, general or municipal election which meets the 7 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article 8 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least 9 10 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is passed by the General Assembly. 11
