## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 25 (Elections) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, in uniform military and overseas voters, further
- 3 providing for definitions, for duties and responsibilities of
- 4 secretary and for registering to vote.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The definition of "military-overseas ballot" in
- 8 section 3502 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 9 Statutes, added October 24, 2012 (P.L.1490, No.189), is amended
- 10 and the section is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 11 § 3502. Definitions.
- 12 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 13 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 14 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 15 \* \* \*
- 16 <u>"Electronic vote." A vote cast and transmitted through</u>
- 17 <u>electronic means which includes, but is not limited to, e-mail</u>

- 1 or fax.
- 2 \* \* \*
- 3 "Military-overseas ballot." All of the following:
- 4 (1) A Federal write-in absentee ballot.
- 5 (2) A ballot specifically prepared or distributed for
- 6 use by a covered voter in accordance with this chapter.
- 7 (3) A ballot cast by a covered voter in accordance with
- 8 this chapter.
- 9 <u>(4) An electronic ballot.</u>

- 11 Section 2. Sections 3503(c) and 3505(c) of Title 25, added
- 12 October 24, 2012 (P.L.1490, No.189), are amended to read:
- 13 § 3503. Duties and responsibilities of secretary.
- 14 \* \* \*
- 15 (c) Other duties. -- The secretary shall do all of the
- 16 following:
- 17 (1) Establish an electronic transmission system through
- 18 which a covered voter may apply for and receive voter
- 19 registration materials, military-overseas ballots and other
- 20 information under this chapter.
- 21 (2) Develop standardized absentee-voting materials and
- their electronic equivalents, authentication materials and
- voting instructions to be used with the military-overseas
- 24 ballot of a voter authorized to vote in any jurisdiction in
- 25 this Commonwealth.
- 26 (3) To the extent reasonably possible, coordinate with
- other states to carry out the provisions of this subsection.
- 28 (4) Prescribe the form and content of a declaration for
- use by a covered voter who does not use the Federal write-in
- 30 absentee ballot in accordance with the following:

- 1 (i) The declaration shall require the covered voter
  2 to swear or affirm, under penalty of perjury, specific
  3 representations pertaining to the voter's:
- 4 (A) identity;
- 5 (B) eligibility to vote;
  - (C) status as a covered voter; and
- 7 (D) timely and proper completion of a military-8 overseas ballot.
- 9 (ii) The declaration shall be based on the FWAB

  10 declaration, as modified to be consistent with this

  11 chapter.
- (iii) The secretary shall ensure that a form for the execution of the declaration, including an indication of the date of execution of the declaration, is a prominent part of all balloting materials for which the declaration is required.
- 17 <u>(5) Establish an electronic transmission system in which</u>
- 18 <u>a covered voter under this chapter may cast an electronic</u>
- 19 vote.

- 22 (c) Electronic transmission system.—The secretary shall
- 23 ensure that the electronic transmission system described in
- 24 section 3503(c) (relating to duties and responsibilities of
- 25 secretary) is capable of accepting a Federal postcard
- 26 application, military-overseas ballot and any other approved
- 27 electronic registration application sent to the appropriate
- 28 county election board. The voter may use the electronic
- 29 transmission system or any other approved method to register to
- 30 vote.

- 2 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
