AN ACT

1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for State
3 income tax intercept.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 9778. State income tax intercept.

9 The Department of Revenue shall implement a State income tax
10 refund intercept program similar to the procedures under section
11 466(a)(3) of the Social Security Act (Public Law 74-271, 42
12 U.S.C. § 666(a)(3)) when, in the judgment of the department, it
13 is cost effective to do so for any person owing any restitution
14 as a result of a criminal conviction in this Commonwealth. This
15 section shall only apply to individual State tax returns.

16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
