Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
Statutes, in rules of the road in general, further providing
for maximum speed limits and for alteration of maximum
limits; and, in powers of department and local authorities,
further providing for regulation of traffic on Pennsylvania

- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. Sections 3362(a)(1.1) and (c)(1), 3363 and
- 10 6110(a) and (a.1) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 11 Statutes are amended to read:
- 12 § 3362. Maximum speed limits.
- 13 (a) General rule. -- Except when a special hazard exists that
- 14 requires lower speed for compliance with section 3361 (relating
- 15 to driving vehicle at safe speed), the limits specified in this
- 16 section or established under this subchapter shall be maximum
- 17 lawful speeds and no person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in
- 18 excess of the following maximum limits:
- 19 * * *

- 1 (1.1) [65] $\underline{70}$ miles per hour for all vehicles on
- 2 freeways where the department has posted a [65-miles-per-
- 3 hour] 70-miles-per-hour speed limit.
- 4 * * *
- 5 (c) Penalty.--
- 6 (1) Any person violating this section is guilty of a
- 7 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to
- 8 pay a fine of:
- 9 (i) \$42.50 for violating a maximum speed limit of 65
- miles per hour <u>or 70 miles per hour;</u> or
- 11 (ii) \$35 for violating any other maximum speed
- 12 limit.
- 13 * * *
- 14 § 3363. Alteration of maximum limits.
- On highways under their respective jurisdictions, local
- 16 authorities subject to section 6109(e) (relating to specific
- 17 powers of department and local authorities) or the department,
- 18 upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, may
- 19 determine that the maximum speed permitted under this subchapter
- 20 is greater or less than is reasonable and safe under the
- 21 conditions found to exist upon any such highway or part thereof
- 22 and establish a reasonable and safe maximum limit. The maximum
- 23 speed limit may be made effective at all times or at times
- 24 indicated and may vary for different weather conditions and
- 25 other factors bearing on safe speeds. No maximum speed greater
- 26 than 55 miles per hour shall be established under this section
- 27 except on highways listed in section 3362(a)(1.1) (relating to
- 28 maximum speed limits), where the maximum speed for all vehicles
- 29 shall not be greater than [65] 70 miles per hour.
- 30 § 6110. Regulation of traffic on Pennsylvania Turnpike.

- 1 (a) General rule. -- The provisions of this title apply upon
- 2 any turnpike or highway under the supervision and control of the
- 3 Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission unless specifically modified by
- 4 rules and regulations promulgated by the commission which shall
- 5 become effective only upon publication in accordance with law. A
- 6 copy of the rules and regulations, so long as they are
- 7 effective, shall be posted at all entrances to the turnpike or
- 8 highway for the inspection of persons using the turnpike or
- 9 highway. This section does not authorize the establishment of a
- 10 maximum speed limit greater than 55 miles per hour, except that
- 11 [a] 65-miles-per-hour and 70-miles-per-hour maximum speed
- 12 [limit] <u>limits</u> for all vehicles may be established where the
- 13 commission has posted [a] 65-miles-per-hour and 70-miles-per-
- 14 <u>hour</u> speed [limit] <u>limits</u>.
- 15 (a.1) Posting. -- No maximum speed limit established under
- 16 subsection [(a)(1) or (2)] (a) shall be effective unless posted
- 17 on fixed or variable official traffic-control devices erected
- 18 after each interchange on the portion of highway on which the
- 19 speed limit is in effect and wherever else the commission shall
- 20 determine.

- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
