- 8 (B) REPEAT OFFENSES WITHIN TEN YEARS. -- THE CALCULATION OF
- 9 PRIOR OFFENSES FOR PURPOSES OF SECTIONS 1553(D.2) (RELATING TO
- 10 OCCUPATIONAL LIMITED LICENSE), 3803 (RELATING TO GRADING) AND
- 11 3804 (RELATING TO PENALTIES) SHALL INCLUDE ANY CONVICTION,
