AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in trade and commerce, providing for 2 the offense of providing false consumer information to 3 consumer reporting agency. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 7332. Providing false consumer information to consumer 10 reporting agency. 11 (a) Offense defined. -- No person shall provide consumer 12 information that: 13 (1) is inaccurate, incomplete or incapable of being verified about a consumer; and 14 15 (2) has the effect of lowering the credit rating of the 16 consumer to a consumer reporting agency for use in a consumer report 17 18 relating to the consumer.

- 1 (b) Penalty. -- A person who commits a violation of this
- 2 <u>section commits a misdemeanor of the third degree and shall,</u>
- 3 upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$1,000 for each
- 4 violation.
- 5 (c) Definitions. -- The words and phrases used in this section
- 6 shall have the same meaning given to them in the Fair Credit
- 7 Reporting Act (Public Law 91-508, 15 U.S.C. §1681 et seq.).
- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
