## AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in riot, disorderly conduct and
- related offenses, further providing for the offense relating
- 4 to police animals.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 5511.2(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 9 § 5511.2. Police animals.
- 10 \* \* \*
- 11 (b) Illegal to torture police animals. -- It shall be unlawful
- 12 for any person to willfully or maliciously torture, mutilate,
- 13 injure, disable, poison or kill a police animal. Any person who
- 14 violates any of the provisions of this subsection commits a
- 15 felony of the [third] second degree.

- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
