AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 24, 1976 (P.L.424, No.101), entitled,
- as amended, "An act providing for the payment of death 2

- enforcement officers or National Guard members who die as a 5
- result of the performance of their duties, " further providing 6
- for certification of death.
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. Section 1(a) of the act of June 24, 1976
- 11 (P.L.424, No.101), referred to as the Emergency and Law
- 12 Enforcement Personnel Death Benefits Act, amended October 9,
- 13 2009 (P.L.588, No.51), is amended to read:
- 14 Section 1. (a) In the event a law enforcement officer,
- 15 ambulance service or rescue squad member, firefighter, certified
- 16 hazardous material response team member or National Guard member
- 17 dies as a result of the performance of his duties, such
- political subdivision, Commonwealth agency or, in the case of
- 19 National Guard members, the Adjutant General, or, in the case of

- 1 a member of a Commonwealth law enforcement agency, the
- 2 authorized survivor or the agency head, within [90 days] three
- 3 <u>years</u> from the date of death, shall submit certification of such
- 4 death to the Commonwealth.

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
