AN ACT

1 Amending the act of July 28, 1953 (P.L.723, No.230), entitled,  
2 as amended, "An act relating to counties of the second class  
3 and second class A; amending, revising, consolidating and  
4 changing the laws relating thereto," in employees' retirement  
5 system, further providing for exceptions in favor of  
6 employees totally and permanently disabled.

7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
8 hereby enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Section 1711 of the act of July 28, 1953  
10 (P.L.723, No.230), known as the Second Class County Code, is  
11 amended by adding a subsection to read:

12 Section 1711. Exceptions in Favor of Employes Totally and  
13 Permanently Disabled.--\* \* \*

14 (d) Notwithstanding any provision of this act, any member of  
15 the police force or the fire department, and any county  
16 detective, sheriff or deputy sheriff may receive a retirement  
17 allowance plus a service increment, if any, in accordance with  
18 the provisions of section 1712, if he or she incurs a permanent  
19 mental or physical impairment in the line of duty that renders  
20 him or her unable to perform his or her duties, regardless of

1 his or her age or service years.

2       Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
