- 11 Section 501. Transfers prohibited.
- 12 There is no authority for the State Treasurer, the Secretary
- 13 of the Budget, the Secretary of Revenue or the Pennsylvania
- 14 Gaming Control Board to transfer any money within or between the
- 15 appropriations in Part III.
- 16 Section 502. Effective date.
- 17 This act shall take effect July 1, 2014, or immediately,
- 18 whichever is later.
