AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 28, 1995 (P.L.89, No.18), entitled "An act creating the Department of Conservation and Natural 2 Resources consisting of certain functions of the Department 3 of Environmental Resources and the Department of Community Affairs; renaming the Department of Environmental Resources as the Department of Environmental Protection; defining the 6 role of the Environmental Quality Board in the Department of 7 Environmental Protection; making changes to responsibilities 8 of the State Conservation Commission and the Department of 9 Agriculture; transferring certain powers and duties to the 10 Department of Health; and repealing inconsistent acts," 11 defining "certified lifeguard"; and providing for certified 12 lifequard requirement in State parks with public beaches. 13 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 15 hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. Section 103 of the act of June 28, 1995 (P.L.89, No.18), known as the Conservation and Natural Resources Act, is 17 amended by adding a definition to read: 18 Section 103. Definitions. 19 20 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall 21 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 23 "Certified lifequard." A certified lifequard is one that

- 1 possesses a valid certificate from a nationally recognized
- 2 organization that certifies lifequards such as the American Red
- 3 Cross or the American Lifequard Association.

- 5 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 6 <u>Section 323. Certified lifeguard requirement in State parks</u>
- 7 <u>with public beaches.</u>
- 8 (a) Peak time requirement. -- The department shall employ a
- 9 sufficient number of certified lifequards to provide water
- 10 <u>safety and lifesaving services to patrons in each State park</u>
- 11 that has a public beach during peak times as the public beach is
- 12 open to patrons. The department shall consult with local parks
- 13 to determine such peak times.
- 14 (b) Nonpeak times. -- The department shall consult with local
- 15 parks to determine appropriate staffing levels during nonpeak
- 16 times.
- 17 (c) Notification. -- Information shall be posted at each
- 18 beach, on all brochures and on the department's and State parks'
- 19 websites to notify the public of the staffing schedule and to
- 20 warn the public that they are swimming at their own risk during
- 21 those periods when no lifequards are on duty. The notices shall
- 22 include specific dates and times and must be written in both
- 23 English and Spanish.
- 24 (d) Rules and regulations. -- The department may promulgate
- 25 rules and regulations to administer and enforce this section.
- 26 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
