AN ACT

1 Amending Title 62 (Procurement) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for  
3 reciprocal limitations.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 107(d) of Title 62 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 107. Reciprocal limitations.

10 (d) Preference for resident bidders or offerors.--

11 (1) When a contract for construction or supplies  
12 [exceeding the amount established by the department for small  
13 procurements under section 514] is to be awarded, a resident  
14 bidder or offeror shall be granted a preference as against a  
15 nonresident bidder or offeror [from any state that]  
16 regardless of whether or not the state in which the  
17 nonresident bidder or offeror resides gives or requires a  
18 preference to bidders or offerors from that state.

1           (2) The amount of the preference shall be equal to [the  
2 amount of the preference applied by the state of the  
3 nonresident bidder or offeror] 10%.

5           Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
