- 7 Section 1. The definition of "serious physical neglect" in
- 8 section 6303 of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 9 Statutes is amended to read:
- 10 § 6303. Definitions.
- 11 (a) General rule. -- The following words and phrases when used
- 12 in this chapter shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 13 section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 14 * * *
- "Serious physical neglect." Any of the following when
- 16 committed by a perpetrator that endangers a child's life or
- 17 health, threatens a child's well-being, causes bodily injury or
- 18 impairs a child's health, development or functioning:

- 1 (1) A repeated, prolonged or egregious failure to
- 2 supervise a child in a manner that is appropriate considering
- 3 the child's developmental age and abilities.
- 4 (2) The failure to provide a child with adequate
- 5 essentials of life, including food, shelter with running
- 6 <u>water</u> or medical care.
- 7 * * *
- 8 Section 2. Section 6304(a) of Title 23 is amended to read:
- 9 § 6304. Exclusions from child abuse.
- 10 (a) Environmental factors. -- No child shall be deemed to be
- 11 physically or mentally abused based on injuries that result
- 12 solely from environmental factors, such as inadequate housing,
- 13 <u>except shelter with lack of running water</u>, furnishings, income,
- 14 clothing and medical care, that are beyond the control of the
- 15 parent or person responsible for the child's welfare with whom
- 16 the child resides. This subsection shall not apply to any child-
- 17 care service as defined in this chapter, excluding an adoptive
- 18 parent.

- 20 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
