- Designating March 19, 2013, as "Arts Education Advocacy Day" in Pennsylvania.

- 6 and the humanities; and
- 7 WHEREAS, A quality arts education strengthens the development
- 8 of cognitive and social skills, such as creativity, confidence,
- 9 problem solving, communication, perseverance and focus, that are
- 10 crucial in the preparation of all Pennsylvania students for
- 11 future growth; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Engagement in the arts encourages engagement across
- 13 all subject areas and promotes overall academic success; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Experiences in art-making and performing help
- 15 students discover, cultivate and share their unique talents as
- 16 gifts to society; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Students benefit when arts experiences help to
- 18 transcend cultural barriers, evoke universal emotions and reveal

- 1 the ever-changing society in which we live; and
- 2 WHEREAS, An investment in arts education is an investment in
- 3 an educated and productive citizenry and workforce; therefore be
