## A RESOLUTION

Recognizing the 50th anniversary of the United States Supreme Court decision in Gideon v. Wainwright that affirmed the right to counsel in criminal cases.

WHEREAS, March 18, 2013, marked the 50th anniversary of the landmark legal decision of the United States Supreme Court in Gideon v. Wainwright; and

WHEREAS, The important decision announced that the right to counsel in criminal cases as provided by the Sixth Amendment to the Constitution of the United States was a fundamental right and that it applied to the states through the Fourteenth Amendment of the Constitution of the United States; and WHEREAS, The decision and the story concerning it were memorialized in the book by Anthony Lewis entitled Gideon's Trumpet which has been listed as required reading for some first year law students, and the book was later depicted in a film of the same name starring Henry Fonda; and

WHEREAS, The impact of that historic judicial decision was the creation and expansion of the public defender system in the
