A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the 50th anniversary of the United States Supreme
2 Court decision in *Gideon v. Wainwright* that affirmed the
3 right to counsel in criminal cases.

4 WHEREAS, March 18, 2013, marked the 50th anniversary of the
5 landmark legal decision of the United States Supreme Court in
6 *Gideon v. Wainwright*; and

7 WHEREAS, The important decision announced that the right to
8 counsel in criminal cases as provided by the Sixth Amendment to
9 the Constitution of the United States was a fundamental right
10 and that it applied to the states through the Fourteenth
11 Amendment of the Constitution of the United States; and

12 WHEREAS, The decision and the story concerning it were
13 memorialized in the book by Anthony Lewis entitled *Gideon's*
14 *Trumpet* which has been listed as required reading for some first
15 year law students, and the book was later depicted in a film of
16 the same name starring Henry Fonda; and

17 WHEREAS, The impact of that historic judicial decision was
18 the creation and expansion of the public defender system in the

1 United States for the representation of indigent offenders in
2 criminal cases; and

3 WHEREAS, The importance of the public defender system in this
4 Commonwealth and indigent defense was the subject of a Joint
5 State Government Commission Report issued in December 2011 that
6 was established by Senate Resolution 42 of 2007; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the 50th anniversary of
8 the United States Supreme Court decision in *Gideon v. Wainwright*
9 that affirmed the right to counsel in criminal cases; and be it
10 further

11 RESOLVED, That the Commonwealth recognize the essential work
12 of the men and women who provide this fundamental service in the
13 criminal justice system.
