## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of April 2013 as "Sexual Assault Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, One in five college women in the United States will
- 4 be a victim of sexual assault by the time she graduates; and
- 5 WHEREAS, One in four girls and one in six boys in the United
- 6 States will be sexually assaulted by the age of 18; and
- 7 WHEREAS, One in five women and one in 71 men will be raped at
- 8 some point in their lives; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Rape is the most under-reported crime, with 63% of
- 10 sexual assaults not reported to the police; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Sexual assault affects women, children and men of
- 12 all racial, cultural and economic backgrounds; and
- 13 WHEREAS, In addition to the immediate physical and emotional
- 14 effects of sexual assault, sexual assault may also lead to post-
- 15 traumatic stress disorder, substance abuse, depression,
- 16 homelessness, eating disorders and suicide; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Sexual assault can be devastating not only for the

- 1 survivor but also for the family and friends of the survivor;
- 2 and
- 3 WHEREAS, Attaining the goal of preventing and ending sexual
- 4 violence begins by raising public awareness of the prevalence
- 5 and effects of sexual assault; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Designating the month of April 2013 as "Sexual
- 7 Assault Awareness Month" will allow residents of this
- 8 Commonwealth to learn more about preventing sexual violence;
- 9 therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of April 2013
- 11 as "Sexual Assault Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
