A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and legacy of Margaret H. Thatcher, former
2 Prime Minister of the United Kingdom.

3 WHEREAS, Margaret H. Thatcher passed away Monday, April 8,
4 2013; and

5 WHEREAS, Mrs. Thatcher served as Prime Minister of the United
6 Kingdom from 1979 to 1990, making her the longest serving Prime
7 Minister of the United Kingdom during the 20th century; and

8 WHEREAS, Mrs. Thatcher was the first and only woman to serve
9 in the role of Prime Minister of the United Kingdom; and

10 WHEREAS, Mrs. Thatcher exemplified a life-long commitment to
11 advancing freedom, liberty and democracy; and

12 WHEREAS, Mrs. Thatcher showed leadership, conviction and
13 friendship in continuing the strong alliance between the United
14 States and the United Kingdom during a tumultuous period of
15 international affairs; and

16 WHEREAS, Mrs. Thatcher, was a champion of peace and a
17 stalwart ally of the United States of America in opposing the

1 spread of communism and bringing an end to the Cold War;

3 RESOLVED, That the Senate of Pennsylvania honor the life and

4 legacy of Margaret H. Thatcher and remember her unwavering

5 friendship with the United States of America.
