A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing recent acts of intolerance by recently resigned Coatesville Area School District Superintendent Richard Como and High School Athletic Director Jim Donato and condemning
- 4 similar expressions of intolerance and discrimination.
- 5 WHEREAS, The Coatesville Area School District is one of the
- 6 most racially diverse in the Philadelphia suburbs and the most
- 7 racially diverse in Chester County, with about 42% African-
- 8 American students; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mr. Como and Mr. Donato were employed by the
- 10 Coatesville Area School District when they engaged in a series
- 11 of text messages referencing lewd, sexist and racial slurs on
- 12 school district-issued phones; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Mr. Como and Mr. Donato were entrusted with the care
- 14 and education of all students enrolled in the Coatesville Area
- 15 School District; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Mr. Como's and Mr. Donato's actions were a direct
- 17 violation of that trust and duty of care; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The Senate vigorously embraces all humanity and

- 1 emphatically rejects expressions, actions or practices of
- 2 intolerance and discrimination; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Accordingly, we must highlight and speak out to
- 4 prevent acts of discrimination, exclusion or restriction on the
- 5 basis of race, religion, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation
- 6 or socioeconomic condition; therefore be it
- 7 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize recent acts of
- 8 intolerance in this Commonwealth and strongly condemn similar
- 9 expressions of intolerance and discrimination.
