A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating February 7 through 14, 2014, as "Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Designating February 7 through 14, 2014, as
4	Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week in Pennsylvania promotes
5	greater public awareness about congenital heart defects; and
6	WHEREAS, Congenital heart defects are the most common type of
7	birth defects in the United States; and
8	WHEREAS, Each year approximately 40,000 babies in the United
9	States are born with congenital heart defects; and
10	WHEREAS, Pulse oximetry newborn screenings can identify some
11	infants with congenital heart defects before they show signs of
12	the condition; and
13	WHEREAS, A pulse oximetry newborn screening is a noninvasive
14	test to identify the levels of hemoglobin in the blood; and
15	WHEREAS, Once congenital heart defects are identified, babies
16	can receive treatment that can prevent death or disability; and
17	WHEREAS, More than 50% of all children born with congenital

heart defects will require at least one invasive surgery in
their lifetime; and

3 WHEREAS, Almost half of all children and adults with complex 4 congenital heart defects have neurological and developmental 5 disabilities; and

6 WHEREAS, For every dollar the Commonwealth spends on medical 7 funding, only a fraction of a penny is directed toward 8 congenital heart defect research; and

9 WHEREAS, Over the last decade, death rates for congenital 10 heart defects have declined by almost 30% due to advances made 11 through congenital heart defect research; and

12 WHEREAS, There are approximately two million congenital heart 13 defect survivors in the United States; and

14 WHEREAS, Greater public awareness about congenital heart 15 defects and the use of pulse oximetry newborn screenings can 16 save lives; therefore be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the week of February 7 18 through 14, 2014, as "Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week" in 19 Pennsylvania.
