1 2 3	Recognizing the week of May 3 through 11, 2014, as "National Travel and Tourism Week" and May 5, 2014, as "Tourism Day" in Pennsylvania.
4	WHEREAS, National Travel and Tourism Week and Tourism Day
5	are designed to draw attention to and recognize the economic,
6	social and cultural impacts of travel and tourism in this
7	Commonwealth and the United States; and
8	WHEREAS, National Travel and Tourism Week was established in
9	1983 when the Congress of the United States passed a joint
10	resolution designating a week in May 1984 as National Travel and
11	Tourism Week and President Ronald Reagan signed a Presidential
12	Proclamation urging citizens to observe the week with
13	appropriate ceremonies and activities; and
14	WHEREAS, Travel and tourism consistently rank as one of the
15	greatest generators of economic activity and jobs for this
16	Commonwealth; and
17	WHEREAS, Tourism is the second largest industry in this

Commonwealth, contributing approximately \$38.4 billion in
 visitor spending and generating more than \$4 billion in State
 and local taxes in 2012; and

WHEREAS, One out of every 16 workers in this Commonwealth is
supported by travel and tourism accounting for 470,953 jobs,
equivalent to 6.5% of the State's total employment; and
WHEREAS, This Commonwealth hosted nearly 192.3 million
domestic and international travelers for business and leisure in
2012; and

10 WHEREAS, Travel and tourism in this Commonwealth allow 11 Pennsylvanians and other travelers to see the spectacular 12 natural scenery, world-class cities, historic towns, dozens of 13 museums and award-winning entertainment and cultural events this 14 Commonwealth has to offer; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the week of May 3 through 16 11, 2014, as "National Travel and Tourism Week" and May 5, 2014, 17 as "Tourism Day" in Pennsylvania.
