WHEREAS, The association provides a vehicle through which
members can converge, examine their positions on issues and
address the needs of their colleagues; and

WHEREAS, The association prides itself on its core values, which include accountability, continuous improvement, diversity, education and training, human life, innovation, the laws and Constitution of this Commonwealth, problem solving, compassion, cooperation, excellence, fairness, inclusion, integrity, personal autonomy and professionalism; and
