A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the 75th anniversary of Little League Baseball.
- WHEREAS, On June 6, 1939, the first Little League Baseball
- 3 game was played in the city of Williamsport, Lycoming County,
- 4 under the direction of Carl Edwin Stotz: and
- 5 WHEREAS, The Little League program in 1939 consisted of three
- 6 teams, all in Williamsport, and by 1946 there were 12 such
- 7 programs, all in this Commonwealth; and
- 8 WHEREAS, By 1955, Little League was found in every state in
- 9 the nation; and
- 10 WHEREAS, In 2014, in this Commonwealth, there are now 410
- 11 leagues, with over 10,000 teams and 150,000 youth who
- 12 participate in the Little League Baseball program; and
- WHEREAS, Today, Little League Baseball is played in 92
- 14 countries across the globe, with 2.5 million youngsters

- 1 participating, and the program culminates in a World Series each
- 2 year; and
- 3 WHEREAS, From its inception, Little League Baseball has been
- 4 a vehicle for a program to promote the attributes of fair play,
- 5 good sportsmanship and a desire to excel through friendly
- 6 competition; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Over one million adult volunteers give of their
- 8 time, energy and ability to make this program possible; and
- 9 WHEREAS, This year marks major milestones in the history of
- 10 Little League, with the celebrations of the 40th Anniversary of
- 11 Little League Softball, 25th Anniversary of the Little League
- 12 Challenger Division and the 15th Anniversary of the Little
- 13 League Urban Initiative; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Little League has been honored as the only youth
- 15 sports organization to be chartered by the United States
- 16 Congress and remains the only regularly scheduled international
- 17 sporting event in this Commonwealth; and
- 18 WHEREAS, In 1959, President Dwight D. Eisenhower proclaimed
- 19 the first "Little League Baseball Week" the second week in June,
- 20 an event that is celebrated every year by members throughout the
- 21 country; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Hundreds of Major League Baseball players and
- 23 leaders in politics, business and industry are Little League
- 24 graduates; and
- 25 WHEREAS, The goals of Little League Baseball have always been
- 26 and will remain to instill in children the values of teamwork,
- 27 discipline and responsibility through a simple, fun game of
- 28 baseball; and
- 29 WHEREAS, Since 1939, and far into the next century, the value
- 30 of Little League Baseball will be measured more by what a child

- 1 learns than what the child wins; therefore be it
- 2 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize the 75th anniversary of
- 3 Little League Baseball and the benefits that have been gained by
- 4 our youth throughout those years by virtue of this outstanding
- 5 program; and be it further
- 6 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
- 7 Dr. Davie Jane Gilmour, Chairman of the Little League
- 8 International Board of Directors, and Stephen D. Keener,
- 9 President and Chief Executive Officer of Little League Baseball
- 10 and Softball.
