A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of October 2014 as "Music Therapy Month" in Pennsylvania and recognizing music therapy as a valid
- 3 therapeutic service.
- WHEREAS, According to the American Music Therapy Association
- 5 (AMTA), music therapy is the clinical and evidence-based use of
- 6 music intervention to accomplish individualized goals within a
- 7 therapeutic relationship by a credentialed professional who has
- 8 completed an approved music therapy program; and
- 9 WHEREAS, A board-certified music therapist must earn a degree
- 10 in music therapy at a college or university approved by the AMTA
- 11 and be certified by the Certification Board for Music
- 12 Therapists; and
- 13 WHEREAS, According to the AMTA, music therapy is a health
- 14 field that offers benefits across all developmental domains and
- 15 supports individuals of all ages and ability levels, including
- 16 infants, children, adolescents, adults and seniors; and
- 17 WHEREAS, More than 41,000 Pennsylvanians receive music

- 1 therapy each year; and
- 2 WHEREAS, More than 420 board-certified music therapists work
- 3 in this Commonwealth; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Nine institutions of higher learning in Pennsylvania
- 5 offer degrees in music therapy; therefore be it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of October 2014
- 7 as "Music Therapy Month" in Pennsylvania.
