## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing November 10, 2014, as "Marine Corps Day" in
- Pennsylvania in honor of the United States Marine Corps'
- 3 239th anniversary of its founding.
- WHEREAS, On November 10, 1775, the Second Continental
- 5 Congress met in Philadelphia and passed a resolution calling for
- 6 two battalions of Marines to be raised for service as landing
- 7 forces with the fleet; and
- 8 WHEREAS, That resolution established the Continental Marines
- 9 and marked the birth date of the United States Marine Corps; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Since its first amphibious raid on March 3, 1776,
- 11 the United States Marine Corps has fought with great courage on
- 12 every continent and in every conflict in American history; and
- 13 WHEREAS, During World War I, Marines fought their famed
- 14 battle at Belleau Wood, establishing their reputation of
- 15 toughness and fierceness; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The Marine Corps played a central role in the
- 17 liberation of the Pacific Islands during World War II; and
- 18 WHEREAS, "Raising of the Flag on Iwo Jima," the famous
- 19 photograph by Joe Rosenthal, will always symbolize the triumph

- 1 and glory of the Marine Corps; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The momentum of the Korean War shifted when the
- 3 Marine Corps, in conjunction with the Navy, launched a massive
- 4 amphibious attack at Inchon, surprising the North Koreans by
- 5 putting thousands of United States troops behind enemy lines;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, The Marine Corps participated in major offensives of
- 8 the Vietnam War, engaging in guerrilla warfare, implementing
- 9 unconventional techniques for counterinsurgency and working as
- 10 military advisors to the Republic of Vietnam Marine Corps; and
- 11 WHEREAS, From 1990 to 1992, Marines participated in Operation
- 12 Desert Shield and Operation Desert Storm, leading the liberation
- 13 of Kuwait and the defeat of Iraqi forces; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The Marine Corps continues to make significant
- 15 contributions to the war on terrorism as part of Operation
- 16 Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan and Operation Iraqi Freedom; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Marines truly embody the motto of the Marine Corps:
- 18 "Semper Fidelis," which translates from Latin as "always
- 19 faithful," and signifies the defense of freedom and democracy
- 20 worldwide; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Today, the Marine Corps is a separate branch of the
- 22 United States Armed Forces, distinguishing itself as an
- 23 expeditionary force ready to respond on the ground, in the air
- 24 and by sea; and
- 25 WHEREAS, There are roughly 202,000 individuals currently
- 26 enlisted in the Marine Corps and roughly 40,000 reserve members;
- 27 and
- 28 WHEREAS, Marine Corps Order No. 47, Series 192, written by
- 29 Major Commandant General John A. Lejeune, established the
- 30 mandatory celebration of the Marine Corps' anniversary;

- 1 therefore be it
- 2 RESOLVED, That the Senate recognize November 10, 2014, as
- 3 "Marine Corps Day" in Pennsylvania in honor of the United States
- 4 Marine Corps' 239th anniversary of its founding.
