Commencement of proceedings. 9 (a.3) Notification regarding child abuse investigation .--10 11 (1) If the plaintiff has knowledge of a founded or indicated report of child abuse under Chapter 63 (relating to 12 13 child protective services) involving the defendant, the 14 petition shall include that information together with the 15 name of the investigative agency. (2) The petition shall include notice to the defendant 16 that an order issued under this chapter may have an impact on 17
