- 8 Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known
- as the Public Welfare Code, is amended by adding a section to

- Section 432.25. Eligibility for Persons Convicted of Drug 11
- Distribution. -- Any individual applying for or receiving 12
- 13 Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF), Federal food
- 14 stamps, general assistance or State supplemental assistance and
- 15 who has been convicted of a felony for violating section 13(a)
- (14), (30), (35) or (36) of the act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, 16
- No.64), known as "The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and 17

- 1 Cosmetic Act," shall be ineligible for assistance.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
