A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, further providing for a public school
- 3 system.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 That section 14 of Article III be amended to read:
- 9 § 14. Public school system.
- 10 The General Assembly shall provide for the maintenance and
- 11 support of a thorough and efficient system of public education
- 12 to serve the needs of the Commonwealth. The funding mechanism by
- 13 which the General Assembly provides for substantial and general
- 14 <u>support for public education to satisfy its obligation under</u>
- 15 this section shall provide for the allocation and distribution
- 16 of funding based upon the actual student enrollment in each
- 17 school district for the school year immediately preceding the

- 1 school year for which funding is being allocated and distributed
- 2 and not based upon the amount of funding a school district
- 3 <u>received in a previous school year.</u>
- 4 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
- 5 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the
- 6 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to
- 7 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
- 8 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
- 9 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
- 10 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
- 11 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.
- 12 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this
- 13 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the
- 14 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
- 15 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 16 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
- 17 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such
- 18 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
- 19 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the
- 20 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment
- 21 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first
- 22 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
- 23 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article
- 24 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least
- 25 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is
- 26 passed by the General Assembly.
