AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in offenses in general, prohibiting persons from  
3 smoking in motor vehicles occupied by minors; and prescribing  
4 a penalty.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

9 § 3721. Smoking in motor vehicle occupied by minor.

10 No person may smoke a cigarette, pipe or cigar in a motor  
11 vehicle that is occupied by a minor. An operator of a motor  
12 vehicle who violates this section or permits a person in the  
13 motor vehicle to violate this section commits a summary offense  
14 with a maximum fine of \$25. A conviction under this section  
15 shall occur only as a secondary offense when the operator of a  
16 motor vehicle has been convicted of violating any other  
17 provision of this title.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
