De minimis impact project permits. 14 § 3301. Definitions. 15 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 16 context clearly indicates otherwise: 17

"De minimis impact project." The construction, maintenance,

- 1 testing, repair, rehabilitation or replacement of water
- 2 obstructions and encroachments that create a disturbance that
- 3 affects an area not larger than 1/20 of an acre located within a
- 4 <u>floodway.</u>
- 5 <u>"Department." The Department of Environmental Protection of</u>
- 6 <u>the Commonwealth.</u>
- 7 § 3302. De minimis impact project permits.
- 8 The fee for a permit under 25 Pa. Code Ch. 105 (relating to
- 9 <u>dam safety and waterway management) for a de minimis impact</u>
- 10 project is \$100.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
